PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Our Church is seeking to promote educational mentoring programs for children with the greatest need. Donations are welcome and accepted for the program that: (1) assist such children in receiving support and guidance from a mentor; (2) improve the academic performance of such children; (3) improve interpersonal relationships between such children and their peers, teachers, other adults, and family members; (4) reduce the high school dropout rate of such children; and (5) reduce juvenile delinquency and involvement in negative social structures by such children.

TYPES OF PROJECTS

Donated funds are used to support this Faith-based mentoring program and related activities to serve children with the greatest need in four different age groups, ages 6 through 17 living in urban areas, high-crime areas, or troubled-home environments, or who attend schools with violence problems.

Additional Information

Our main objective is to promote mentoring programs for children with the greatest need by assisting them in receiving support and guidance from a mentor. We seek to improve the academic achievement of these children. (“**Children with greatest need**” is defined as a child at risk of educational failure, dropping out, or becoming involved in criminal or delinquent activities, and who lack positive role models. Supported activities will work to improve interpersonal relationships between targeted children and their peers, teachers, other adults, and family members. Additionally, donated funding to this program will work to reduce the dropout rate of at-risk children and to reduce juvenile delinquency.

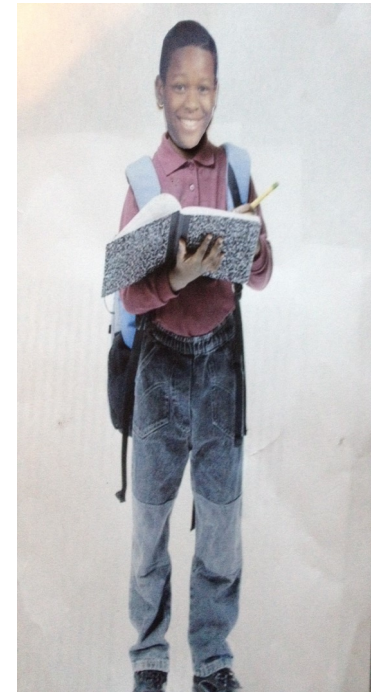
